But, due to this specific condition MSME companies of other states like us are unable to participate in this tender and requested to remove this specific condition which will enable us to participate in this tender.	1). <u>Clarification:</u> As per Rule 45(1) of the Indian Electricity Rules 1956, Precautions to be adopted by consumers, Owners, occupiers, electrical contractors, electrical workmen and suppliers are as follows –(1): No electrical installation work, including additions, alterations, repairs and adjustments to existing installations, except such replacement of lamps, fans, fuses, switches, low voltage domestic appliances and fittings as in no way alters its capacity or character, shall be carried out upon the premises of or on behalf of any 3[consumer, supplier, owner or occupier] for the purpose of supply to such 3[consumer, supplier, owner or occupier] except by an electrical contractor licensed in this behalf by the State Government and under the direct supervision of a person holding a certificate of competency and by a person holding a permit issued or recognized by the State Government. Provided that in the case of works executed for or on behalf of the Central Government and in the case of installations in mines, oil fields and railways, the Central Government and in other cases the State Government, may, by notification in the Official Gazette, exempt on such conditions as it may impose, any such work described therein either generally or in the case of any specified class of consumers, 1[suppliers], owners or occupiers from so much of this sub-rule as requires such work to be carried out by an electrical contractor licensed by the State Government in this behalf. Hence, the tender condition prevails.
